


## **RECENT ACTIVITIES:**

To give an insight into the nature of work done by the society, here is a list of events organized by society in the year 2014-15;

**PRAKRITI BAZAR** : This event was organized as a part of the Annual Fest of the ECO- club. The Club created a market space for a range of eco-friendly products by this initiative. Stalls were freely allowed to be put up in the college for anyone who was interested in selling eco-friendly products.
