Project Hum Sab is an Outreach Program of the College which looks towards sustainable development at the margins, adopting the migrant labor community of construction workers on the College campus for one year, which is likely to be the period of their stay in the College. The project is planned not only with a view to impart enabling skills, information and knowledge to the men, women, youth and children in the workers' camp, but also to develop the values of social responsibility and voluntarism in the College community. The project involves student and faculty volunteers of the College across various academic disciplines with their attendant corpus of knowledge, skill set, methodologies and tools of analysis. **Hum Sab** will also draw on experts and assistance from NGOs and state bodies to achieve its goals. The College will collaborate with appropriate agencies in the areas of:

The Project provides for workshops, presentations, review and course-correction. The daily/weekly/monthly/interim reports will be prepared by an Academic Team. Additionally, there is a Media Cell with a photography unit, for regular flow of information and updates on the social media about the Project. A Managerial team will co-ordinate the various activities and interact with the Media Cell. Volunteers will have the opportunity to rotate their services and skills in a working group of their choice, after serving the minimum period there.

The first activity of **Hum Sab** begins on 7 October 2016 in the season of festivals. The College will host lunch and distribute new clothes to usher in the festivities. A session of personal introductions will follow to forge mutually respectful bonds. The Project will be introduced to the community. Student working groups have been constituted in the work areas delineated on the agenda.

Dr. Babli Moitra Saraf, Principal of the College is the pilot of **Project Hum Sab** and Ms. Dolly Jain, Assistant Professor in the Department of Mathematics with long experience of the NSS, is the Faculty Coordinator. Ms. Asmita of B.Com. (Hons.) 3rd year is the Student Coordinator who works with more than 100 student volunteers.
