

FAQs - CES 2024-2025

1. Who is eligible for admission under CES 2024-2025?
Any person of any age, discipline or profession who may or may not be a student of the University of Delhi.
2. Is there any eligibility criteria for admission under CES 2024-2025?
Yes, the candidate must fill the minimum eligibility norms and pre-requisites, if any, required for admission to that paper.
The Candidate must be a citizen of India.
The Candidate should have passed the Class XII examination of any Board/ University examination in India or in any foreign country recognized as equivalent to the 10+2 system by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU).
The Candidate should have “passed” individually in each subject required (including practicals if any) for eligibility to the paper they seek admission in.
3. How will merit be decided for admission under CES 2024-2025?
On the basis of age and marks obtained in the qualifying examination.
4. Do I need a No Objection Certificate (NOC) if I am from a college affiliated to the University of Delhi?
No.
5. When do I need to have a No Objection Certificate (NOC) for admission?
You need an NOC from
 - a. The head of your institution if you are a full-time student of an institution that is not affiliated to the University of Delhi.
 - b. Your employer, if you are in full-time employment.
6. Is there a limit on the number of students that can be admitted in a course?
Yes. 10% of the total intake for the course or 6 students - the lesser of these two figures is the total admissible number of students that can be enrolled in that course offered by a particular college.
7. Is there a limit on the number of papers that I can take?
You can take up to 2 papers in a semester.
8. I used to be a regular student of the University of Delhi. However I had to leave without getting my degree. Will CES 2024-2025 help me to complete my degree requirements so that I can get my degree?
No. CES 2024-2025 is meant to enhance competencies for upgrading skills. It cannot substitute the rigour of a full-fledged degree course.
9. Is there any fee payable?

Yes, fee for each paper is Rs 6000/- (Rupees six thousand only).

10. Can the fees be refunded if I drop out?

No. Fees, once paid, cannot be refunded.

11. Will I need to pay an examination fee?

No. It is already included in the fee of Rs 6000/- that you will pay for each paper.

12. Will my fees be refunded if I do not sit for the examinations?

No, fees will not be refunded for not sitting in the examinations.

13. In case I do not sit in the examinations, can I take them at a later date?

You will have to register for the paper again, paying the fees again, to get the opportunity of sitting for the examination.

14. Is there a registration fee?

Yes. The registration fee is Rs 100/- (Rupees one hundred only).

15. How many papers can I register for?

You may register for up to 2 papers in a semester.

16. How many credits will I earn per paper?

You can earn up to 4 credits for a paper. The number of credits will depend on the paper that is being offered. Also, since you can take up to 2 papers, you can earn a maximum of 8 credits in an academic semester.

17. Will I be able to choose the college in which I can take a course?

You will be able to opt for any college that is offering the course you are interested in. Final admission will be based on counselling in ILLL.

18. Can I choose the timing of my classes?

No. You must follow the schedule in which classes are offered by the college in which your course is offered.

19. What will be the duration of a course?

One academic semester in the regular mode.

20. What about attendance requirements?

A minimum of 66% classes need to be attended to be eligible to sit for the end-semester exam. This is as per University of Delhi norms.

21. Will I be able to use college facilities?

Yes. You will be able to use facilities like the library in the college in which you enrol for your course/s. The college in which you enrol will inform you about the facilities that you can access.

22. Will I get a certificate for completing the course?

Yes, you will get a certificate upon fulfilling the attendance and evaluation requirements.

23. Who will issue the certificate?

Institute of LifeLong Learning (ILLL), University of Delhi.

24. How will I be able to use the credits gained in a course?

Your credits will be automatically stored in the Academic Bank of Credit.

25. Do we need CUET scores for admission under CES?

No. You need to directly register on the CES portal which is separate from the admission portal of the University of Delhi.
