

Report for Session 2020-21

In line with the College's mandate of enhancing the Alumnae Network, this year was fruitful in engaging with alumnae but in the virtual mode. Amidst the pandemic, just like the entire teaching-learning process shifted to the online mode, so did our Annual Alumnae Meet and interactions. Keeping the earmarked calendar date of the Second Sunday of November, 8 November 2020, we hosted the Annual Alumnae Meet online. All departments continued to establish effective communication channels with their alumnae by inviting them for Talks, Meets, Workshops, Student guidance or in the capacity of Judges for various events over Google Meet. With the help of dedicated Departmental Alumnae Representatives, both the practice of updating Alumnae databases as well as engaging with alumnae have become regular. Our dedicated Google Group has nearly 2200 members and is growing. This year also marked the inclusion of alumnae from the two newer Departments of Geography and Sociology.

Held as a virtual event on 12 November 2020, the second edition of the Annual Shahzad R. Bahadur Debate organized in the memory of an avid debater of the institution, Mrs. Shahzad R Bahadur, witnessed a sizable national turnout of 41 speakers from thirty-five institutions. Further, the panellists of the event were 3 Alumnae Debaters and 3 College Professors (out of which one is also an IPCW alumna). The event was also graced by members of Late Mrs. Shahzad R. Bahadur's family— Ms. Rati Bahadur Singh and Ms. Minakshi Bahadur.


The Departments of B.A. Program, Geography and History invited their alumnae to guide the students how to prepare and appear for the Open Book Examinations.






