In the context of the growing importance of internships in providing adequate hands-on experience to students, an Internship team was set up in September 2017, under the leadership of Ms Shambhavi Chandra, the Internship Coordinator and Ms Bhumika Sood, the Secretary, for proactively working towards getting good internship opportunities. The functions of the team were divided into the following Verticals- Big Forces, Startups, NGOs and Government organizations, and OffBeat Internships.

The team working for Big Forces Vertical has contacted several big companies and organizations for their summer internship program. These include **Ernst&Young, Deloitte, Wipro, Yes Bank**, etc.

Yes Bank offered its summer internship as a part of their Social Change Fellowship programme. Ernst&Young also offered articleship to students.

Startups like **IDBI, Delhivery, Oyo, Consumers India, LBB, Xeno, Roposo, Sociowash, Spectral Management, My Operator, LOL Ventures, ReWello, Xeno**, etc. have approached the Placement Cell with their internships. Communication with some of the companies and startups is still in process.



A major thrust area during the current session has been the NGO and Government Organizations vertical. Keeping in mind departments like Political Science, History and Psychology which require opportunities primarily from the development and government sector, efforts were made to facilitate maximum number of internships from this sector.

Some of the organizations which offered internships are: **Alkazi Foundation, Pratham, Koan Advisory, Centre for Equity Studies**, etc.

It was observed that students in the College were not aware about internship opportunities at various Government Ministries. Though it is not possible to facilitate such internships through the Cell, all the information about internships with different Government Ministries and think tanks are disseminated regularly to students to enable them to apply directly for the same.



Given that several students are interested in exploring career options which are outside their course of study in college, a beginning was made to facilitate offbeat Internships in areas such as Event Management, Photography and Editing, Fine Arts, Theatre, Music, etc. This will be pursued more actively in the next academic session.

Highlights of the session

Pre-Internship talk by Pravah

The Internship team organized a presentation by Pravah- a leading NGO which works with young people to impact issues of social justice through youth citizenship action. The presentation dealt with their “Smile in-turn-ship” during the winter break.



Internship Orientation

An internship orientation was held on January 15, 2018 for first and second year students to create awareness about the importance of internships. Industry expert Mr Nitin Jain, an experienced risk management professional from GRMI and Ms Neeru -Director, Pravah, addressed the session to acquaint students about opportunities in the corporate and development sector. The event saw active participation from first and second year students.



Virtual Internship Fair

A virtual internship fair in collaboration with triedge.in went live on March 22, 2018. It was an all women virtual internship fair, where young women could apply for various positions advertised by partner companies which included **Religare, Reliance, Aviva, Goonj, Jindal Steel, Hyaat, GMR Infrastructure, Bajaj, YES Bank, Max Health Insurance, etc.**



The Internship team aims to develop a culture of quality internships, which provide the right amount of exposure and professionalism to students. We believe that internships enable students to develop their passion and interest and to apply classroom concepts in the real life scenario.

The team aspires to work with even more dedication and professionalism in the coming session, under the guidance of the Faculty Advisor and to achieve all set targets, so as to create a positive space for all the students.
