ORIENTATION PROGRAMME 2018-19

The NSS orientation programme was organised on 7th September, 2018 from 12:30 to 2.30 pm in the Auditorium. The programme witnessed active participation of 449 students. The programme began with a short video, recalling the history of NSS. The emcees Priyanka Thakran and Ojasvi Gupta gave useful insight into the working of the organisation.

The Programme Officer of the new session, (2018-19) Mrs T. Jeya Christy introduced the newly appointed office bearers; Ms. Rohini Yadav, the President; Ms. Rupal Rana, the Vice President; and Ms. Suman Rana, the Secretary. Ms. Riya acquired the recently introduced position of Treasurer. As per the new decentralization policy adopted this year, four separate departments with specific responsibilities will function namely,

- Events department (managing programme organisation, reporting and anchoring etc.)
- Logistics department (providing off stage and infrastructural support etc.)
- Record maintenance & liaison (recording minutes of events maintaining all written records and liaison with all authorities etc)
- Creative department (social media management, IT, acting as a creativity reservoir etc.)

A supporting team, which constitutes of the previous office bearers, was also been established. The introduction was followed by a note by Mrs. Supriya Saha, the ex- Programme Officer of NSS, IPCW.

The Vice-President, Ms. Rupal Rana, explained the objectives of NSS. She then invited Ms. Mamta Mittal, a former core member of NSS, and a graduate of IPCW to share her experience.

The president, Ms. Rohini Yadav welcomed the fresh recruits and introduced them to the various precincts of NSS. She explained, the 'hours policy' and diary and record maintenance, and insight into the success of events conducted during the year 2017-2018, such as SVEEP, Swachhta Pakhwada, EOC and various other events.

The session also included information about the outreach programme, which was conducted by Ms. Tamanna. This was followed by an introduction of the

department representatives by the Secretary, Ms. Riya. The session ended on a successful note with a vote of thanks by the President.
