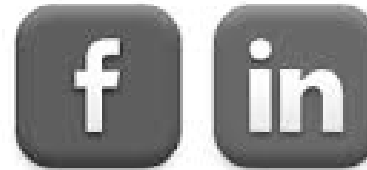

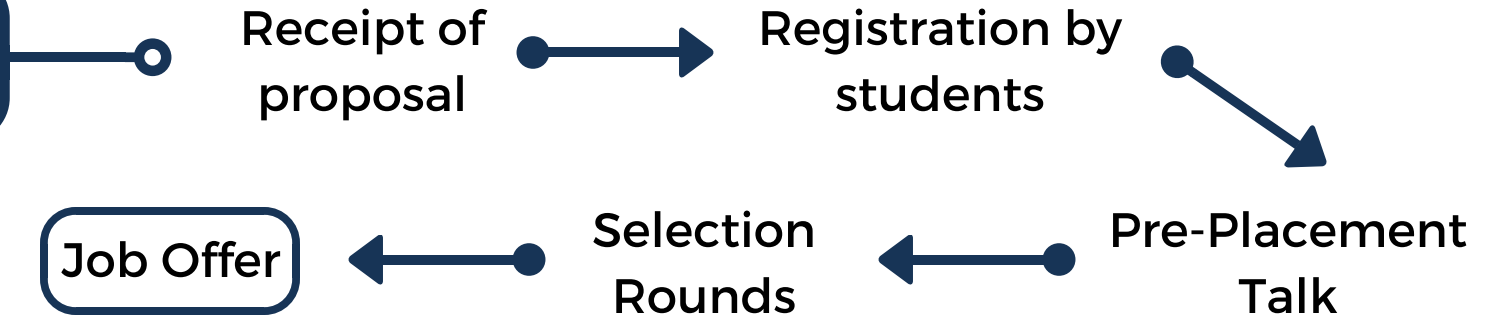

RECRUITMENT PROCESS

Recruitment Phases

- Phase 1: August 1, 2018 - October 31, 2018
- Phase 2: January 15, 2019 - April 15, 2019

Stages in the process



Recruiters are requested to make a note of the following:

- After the Pre-Placement presentation, students are free to decide whether they want to appear for the subsequent hiring process.
- Students registered with the Placement Cell may avail a maximum of two job offers.
- A student accepting a job offer will not be considered for further recruitment drives, in the interest of wider distribution of job opportunities.
- Recruiters are required to route all communication to applicants, including the intimation of job offer, through the Placement Cell, for college records.

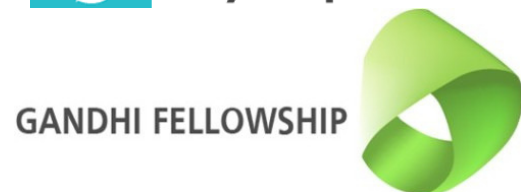
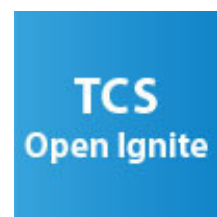
