## 14<sup>th</sup> Annual Public Lecture

Indrapastha College for Women held its 14th **Annual Public Lecture** on Monday, September 16, 2019, at 11:30 a.m in the auditorium. **Mr. Parameswaran Iyer**, Secretary of the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation and a flag bearer of the Swachh Bharat mission was the guest speaker for the occasion.
