Participation in Mega Job Fair (12-03-2019)

The College provided free transportation to the participants to attend the Job Fair. Out of 8 III year students who attended the Fair from IP College, 4 were selected in various companies.



Visit to Anubhav Tactile Gallery in the National Museum (05-04-2019)

On 5 April, 2019, EOC and EU arranged a visit of students with visual disabilities to Anubhav Tactile Gallery in the National Museum, a novel initiative and first of its kind in the country. The students were accompanied by faculty and NSS volunteers. The students have had the experience of touching and feeling certain artefacts dating back to as early as the Harappan civilization. By touching the selected sculptures and paintings the students acquainted themselves with various cultures and visited the pages of history. The information in Braille tabs, the pre- recorded audio guide made available to each visitor in English and Hindi and the committed volunteers made the visit a memorable experience.
