The International Award for Young People (IAYP), the Community Outreach Program of Indraprastha College for Women conducted its orientation for the session 2020-21 on 31st January 2021. The Orientation session was conducted online on Google Meet from 12:30pm to 2:00pm for a total of 290 students who had registered for the same. The session was organized to provide the interested students an extensive introduction to the functioning and activities of the Award Program. The Google Meet witnessed enthusiastic participation with over 90 students marking their presence and over 70 students registering as interested candidates in the program. These included students from across all three years as well as different departments of the college. The students displayed keen interest in the Award Program and made the session interactive with their queries. A short reintroduction of the program was also given for the students who joined late due to technical difficulties. A PowerPoint presentation containing the details of the program was also shared via email with all students who had registered for the orientation session. Overall, the orientation session process for the International Award for Young People (IAYP) was conducted very successfully and as of 24 May 2021, 8 students have registered for the program, 2 students for each of the three levels respectively.
