ORIENTATION REPORT (23rd JANUARY 2022)

The International Award for Young People (IAYP), the Community Outreach Program of Indraprastha College for Women conducted its orientation for the session 2021-22 on 23rd January 2022. The session was conducted online on Google Meet from 01:30pm to 02:30pm for a total of 237 students who had registered for the same. The orientation session was organized to provide the interested students an extensive introduction to the functioning and activities of the Award Program. The Google Meet witnessed zealous participation with over 85 students marking their presence and over 93 students registering as interested candidates in the program. These included students from across all three years as well as different departments of the college. The students displayed keen interest in the Award Program and made the session interactive with their queries. A short reintroduction of the program was also given by the Award Leader, Dr. Supriya Saha, for the students who joined late due to technical difficulties. Additionally, their doubts were also catered to by the IAYP Student Coordinator, Mahira Sharma, after the session through emails and phone calls. A PowerPoint presentation containing the details of the program was also shared via email with all students who had registered for the orientation session. Overall, the orientation session process for the International Award for Young People (IAYP) was conducted very successfully and as of 6th February 2021, 15 students have registered for the program, 8 have registered for Bronze, 1 for Silver and 6 for Gold.
