14 April, 2021:- Wetlands Quiz




22 April, 2021:- Paper Presentation Competition with Documentary Screening


16 September 2021:- Webinar (in collaboration with Centre for Earth Studies)


6 October 2021:- Film Screening


1 November 2021:- Poster Making & Slogan Writing Competition


30 November 2021:- Webinar (in collaboration with Centre for Earth Studies)
