## Gandhi Study Circle Indraprastha College for Women

## A Report of Activities July 2019-May 2020

- 1. A student panel discussion was held on 25 September 2019 on an article by Vinay Lal 'The Gandhi Everyone Loves to Hate' (*Economic and Political Weekly*, 4 October 2008). The article was circulated beforehand, which served as an entry point to explore and critically engage with the topic. The panellists were Saurya Mishra, Tanu Dabral and Pallavi Pradhan. Amisha Pareek, the President of the Gandhi Study Circle, moderated the discussion.
- 2. On 1 October 2019, on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti, the Gandhi Study Circle prepared 'Centennial and Sessquicentennial', an audio visual presentation memorializing the massacre of unarmed civilians at Jallianwala Bagh, Amritsar in 1919 and outlining how this event transformed Gandhi. The presentation also drew attention to the participation of the students of Indraprastha College of Women in the national movement.
- 3. The Gandhi Study Circle was part of the organizing committee of the first inter-college round table conference on Gandhi held on 16 October 2019. The theme of the round table conference was 'Gandhi after Gandhi'.
- 4. A 'Letters to Gandhi' competition was held on 23 January 2020.
- 5. In collaboration with the Students' Union, the Gandhi Study Circle was involved in the activities to mark the observance of Martyrs' Day on 30 January 2020.
