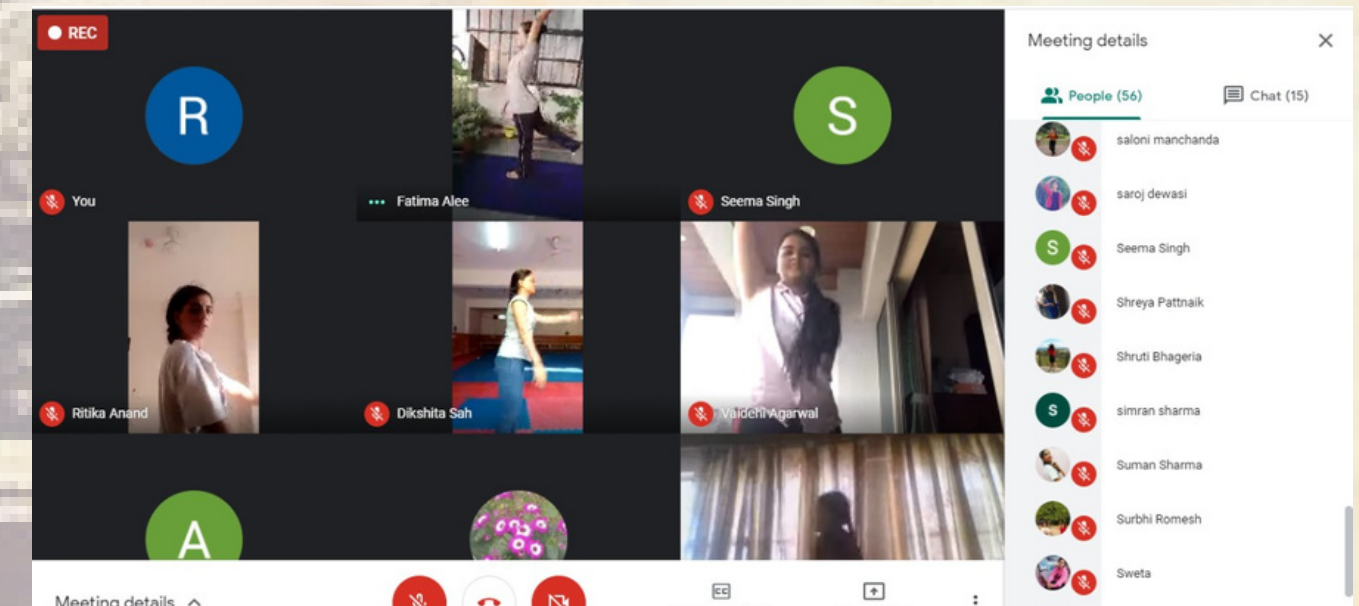

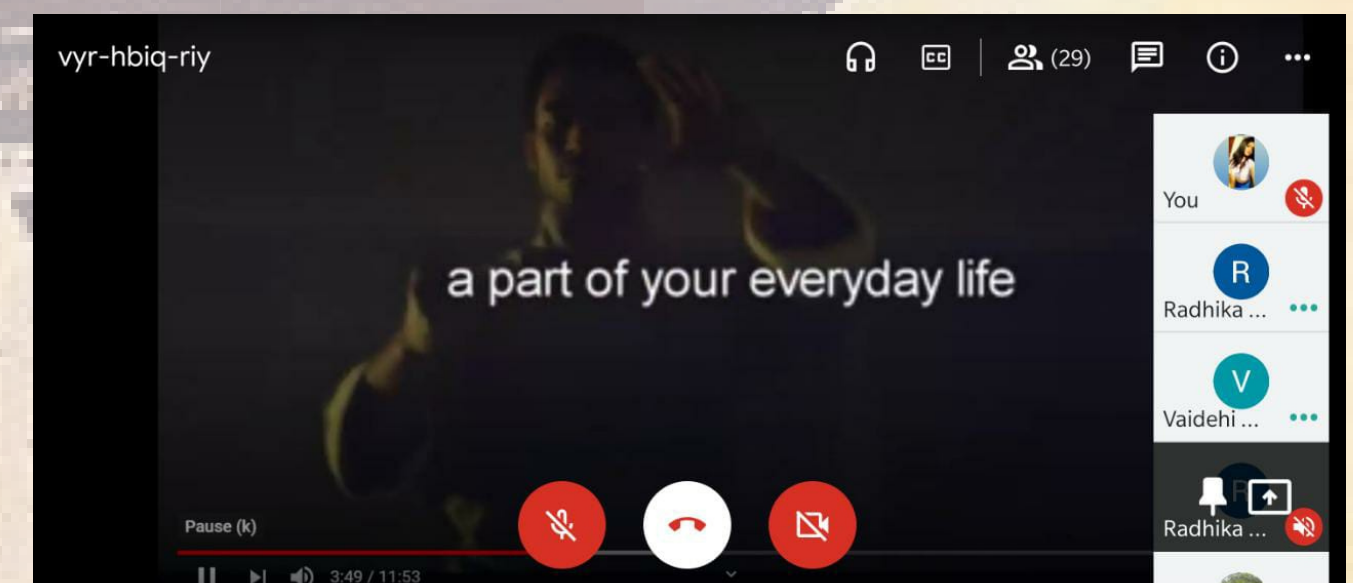
Events conducted by NSS unit of IPCW

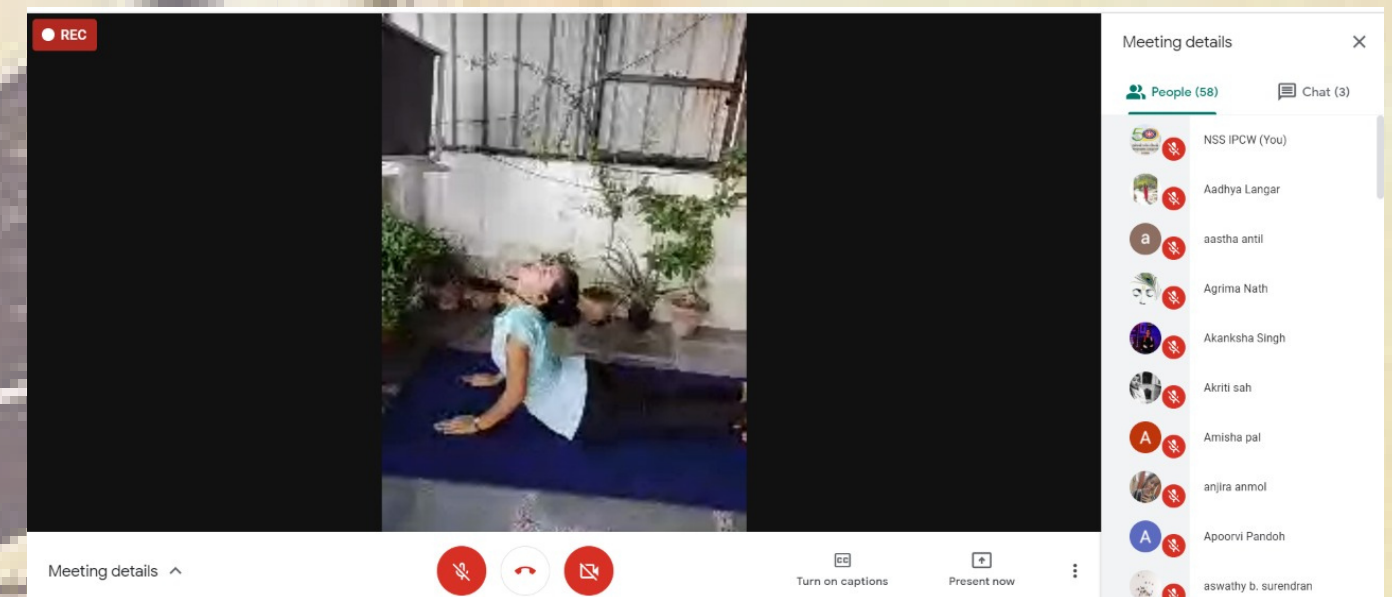

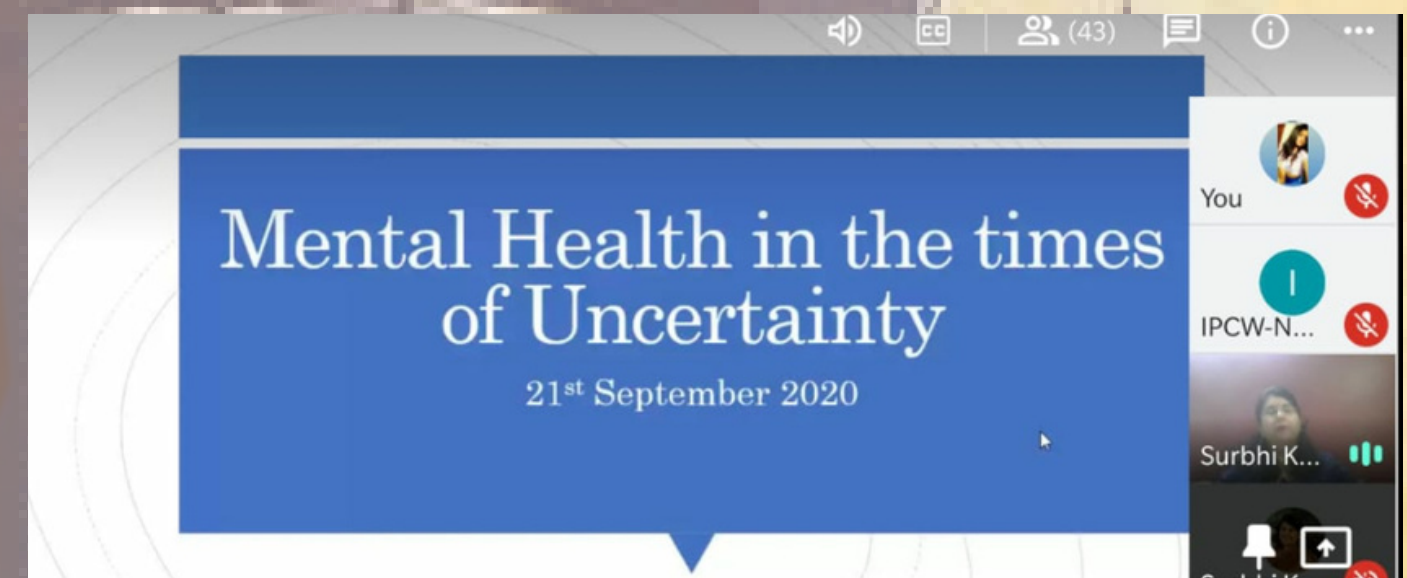

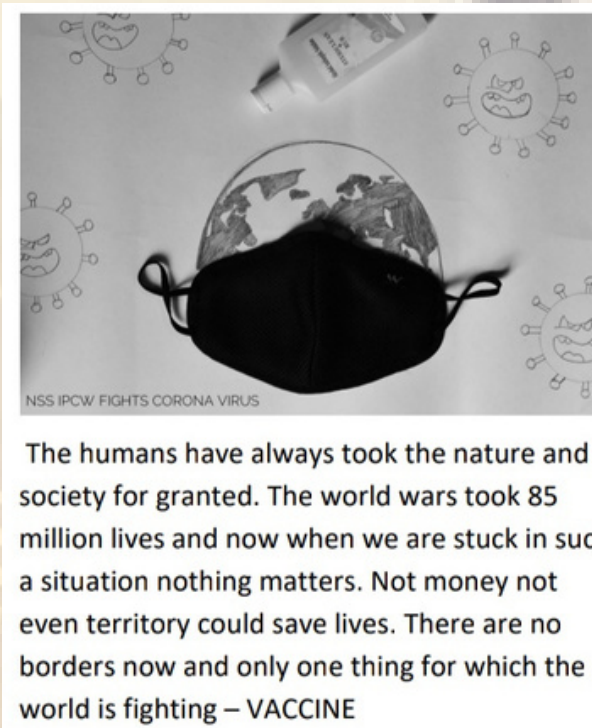
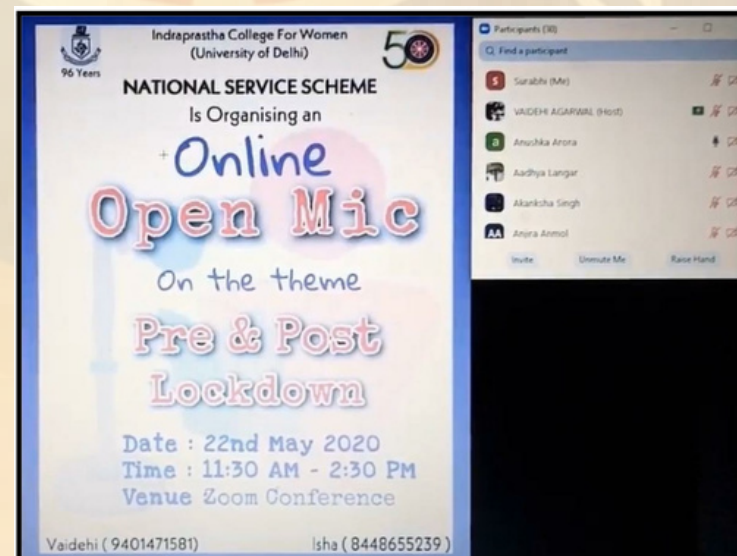


1) Mask-making.

The pandemic and the country lockdown made us share about the shift in our life from " Pre and Post Lockdown."



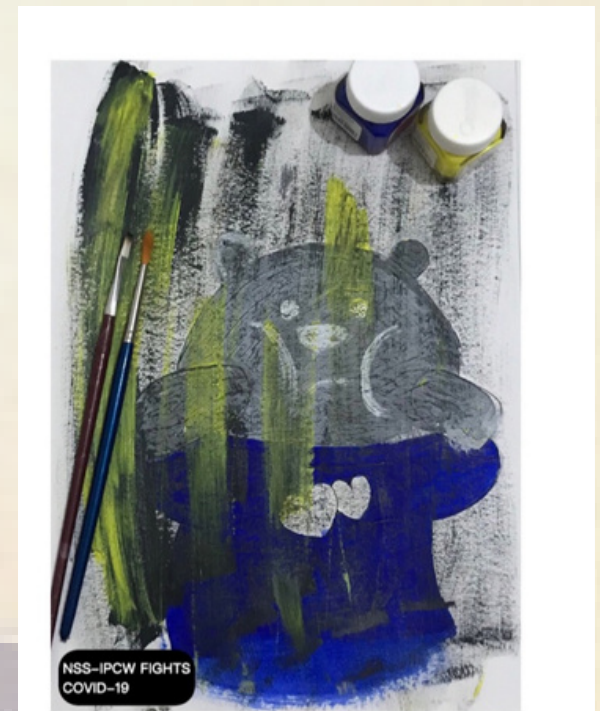
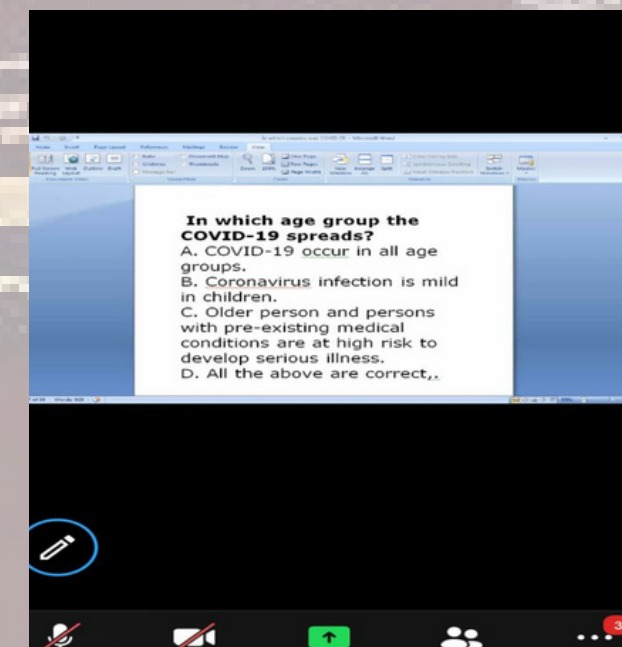
