

The festival began with a soulful rendition of the University of Delhi's Kulgeet. A captivating semi-classical dance, performed by second-year students as part of the opening ceremony, added a touch of elegance to the event.

Two Intra-College Competition, Treasure Hunt on the theme “Celebrating 100 years of Philosophy” and Photography Competition on the theme “Reflection on Philosophy -Capturing the essence of Philosophical Thoughts” were also held simultaneously with the debate competition.
